 - I Timothy 3:1-2, I Peter 5:8, Genesis 3:1-5, Deuteronomy 8:4, Matthew 4:4
 - 4: He Must Be Sober in His Thinking and Ways of Doing Things

B: Godly Leadership Skills

- 1: Good and Godly Behaviour
 - I Timothy 3:2, I Corinthians 9:14, Romans 14:7
- 2: To Be Given To Hospitality
 - I Timothy 3:2
- 3: Apt To Teach
 - I Timothy 3:2
- 4: Not Given To Wine
 - I Timothy 3:3, Proverbs 20:1, Proverbs 23:29-30, Isaiah 5:11, Habakkuk 2:15

C: His Relationship Skills

- I Timothy 3:3-7
 - 1: No Striker (Romans 14:12-13)
 - 2: Not Greedy of Filthy Lucre or Covetous (Matthew 6:19-21, 24-33, I Timothy 6:10)

- 3: To Be Patient, Not Covetous (Luke 23:34)
- 4: Not A Brawler (I Timothy 3:3, Romans 12:18-19, I Corinthians 14:33)
- 5: To Rule His Own House Well (I Timothy 3:4-5, Ephesians 5:22-25)
- 6: Not A Novice (I Timothy 3:6, Proverbs 16:18)
- 7: Must Be of Good Report (I Timothy 3:7, Proverbs 16:7)
