II : It Means Things Have Changed For Me Each Day

A: A New Hunger and Thirst for Righteousness

- Matthew 5:6, John 3:3, I John 1:6-9,

B: A New Friend Versus An Old Enemy

- Psalm 40:3, I Peter 5:8, James 4:7-10, I Thessalonians 5:22, Philippians 3:13-14, Acts 19:18-20

III : It Means Because I Have A New Friend In Jesus, I Too Should Have A New Desire

- Ephesians 4:17-32

A: That New Friend Who Gives Victory Over Sin

- I Peter 2:2, Psalm 119:11, Matthew 6:33

B: That New Friend Who Gives Joy and Peace To Replace Pain and Sorrow

- John 14:27, Joshua 1:5, John 16:33, John 10:10

C: That New Friend Who Gives Wisdom and Strength To Face Each New Day

- Luke 24:15-32
