Our Lesson’s Theme Verse is found in this passage of Scripture...
***“In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel,
with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;
But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.”***
I Timothy 2:9-10

Today’s Lesson Thought can be summed up in this one Statement...
“A Woman That Feareth The Lord, She Shall Be Praised!”

Lesson: ‘What’s A Woman To Do?’

I : The Attire of Women Who Worship

- Let me say this before we get into the actual lesson this morning...the subject of women’s issues sure seems to be a never ending source for contention and emotional debate these days, does it not?!?
- But evidently, this must have been the situation in Paul’s day as well, for we read here in I Timothy 2:9-10, ***“In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array; But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.”***
- Again, before getting saved, many of those who were now saved came from heathen, immoral, and even pagan backgrounds, perhaps even like some of us today!
- And because of this, there was a great need of teaching those folks, especially the women, the proper and Biblical guidelines for things such as God-honouring conduct, attitude, and attire now that they were saved.
- Paul addresses this issue with attire in two phases, first...

A: The Inside Character

- 1: Shamefacedness
 - I Timothy 1:9a
- 2: Sobriety
 - I Timothy 2:9b
- 3: Godliness
 - I Timothy 2:10, Proverbs 31:10

B: The Outside Attire

- Ezekiel 28:17-19
 - 1: In Modest Apparel
 - I Timothy 2:9
 - 2: Not Extravagantly
 - I Timothy 2:9
 - 3: With good works
 - I Timothy 2:10, Ephesians 2:10, Proverbs 31:10-31

II : The Attitude of Women Who Are Willing To Learn

A: Personal Character

- I Timothy 2:11

B: God's Organizational Arrangement

- Note here how God's organizational arrangement is declared in I Timothy 2:11-14...
 - 1: It is Stated
 - I Timothy 2:11, Ephesians 5:22-33, I Peter 3:7
 - 2: It is Applied
 - I Timothy 2:12, Titus 2:1-5
 - 3: It is Supported
 - I Timothy 2:13-14, I Corinthians 11:8-9
 - 4: A Motherly Influence
 - I Timothy 2:15, I Timothy 5:14-15, Proverbs 31:28

Conclusion:

Ladies, never forget just how special you are to God! And men, never forget how good God has been to you to give you that wife—that '*spiritual completer*' so that you can be all God wants you to be in His service in the home, in the workplace, and especially in God's house!

Now men, lead your wife in the right and Biblical way, and encourage and strengthen your wife in the Lord so that she can see Christ in you and you can have the joy and peace of God in your home as God planned there to be!
