A: The Source of Full Assurance Comes Only From God  
- John 14:27, I John 5:11-14, II Peter 3:9

B: The Source of Full Assurance Comes Not From The World  
- Hosea 4:1, I John 2:12-17

C: The Source of Full Assurance Comes From God’s Holy Spirit  
Who Now Dwells Within Us  
- I John 4:1-4, John 14:15-18, 25-26

II : The Song of Full Assurance

A: The Song of Full Assurance Displays A New Heart  
- Psalm 96:1-9

B: The Song of Full Assurance Displays a New Desire  
- Psalm 95:1-8a, John 14:15, I John 2:3-6, Psalm 97:10

C: The Song of Full Assurance Displays The Work God Has Done In Our Life  
- Psalm 98:1-3

III : The Security of Full Assurance

A: I Am Kept Saved By God’s Power and Not My Own Power

- I Peter 1:3-5, John 10:27-30

B: I Am Kept Safe In God's Hand of Salvation

- John 10:27-30

C: I Am Kept Secure By The Author and Finisher of Our Faith

- Hebrews 12:2-3, Romans 8:35-39
