Conclusion:

Folks, here is the point I want you to see in the lesson today...

Paul and Silas did not quit when things got tough, nor did they gripe, and murmur, and complain about the way ‘*God was treating them*’—they stayed on course and remained faithful to do what God had commanded them to do!

And even though they had been physically attacked and falsely accused by those who refused to hear the Gospel, these men of God ‘*chose*’ to remain faithful to do that which God had commanded them to do! And even when they were forced out of Thessalonica because of the threats against their very lives, they immediately began to preach the Gospel as soon as they arrived in the town to where God had sent them to go!

What a great testimony these men had for the cause of Christ, and what an example they have become for you and me to follow after some two thousand plus years later in our day!
