TOPIC: Liberty In Christ

THEME: Christ has set us free from the law

THEME VERSE: Galatians 5:1 *“Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.”*

SCRIPTURE FOCUS: Galatians 4:21 – Galatians 5:1

LESSON SUMMARY:

Abraham’s two sons illustrate the difference between the Judaizers’ teaching and the Gospel of Grace. Abraham’s son Ishmael was born *“after the flesh”*, but Abraham’s other son, Isaac, was born *“by promise”*. Since spiritual blessings spring from promise and not from the flesh, the Galatians needed to stand in the liberty Christ had given unto them.
