Lesson Eight: “The Unjust Suffering of Messiah”

Our Lesson’s Theme Verse is found in this passage of Scripture...
“But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.”
Isaiah 53:5

Today’s Lesson Thought can be summed up in this one simple Statement...
“No One Ever Cared For Me Like Jesus!”

Lesson: ***‘The Unjust Suffering of Messiah’***

- I : The Description of Messiah’s Suffering
 - A: Socially (Isaiah 53:1-3)
 - B: Physically (Isaiah 52:14, Isaiah 53:5)
 - C: Emotionally (Isaiah 53:5-6, 10-12)

- II : The Injustice of Messiah’s Suffering
 - A: The Innocence of the Victim (Isaiah 53:7-10)
 - B: The Irregularities of the Trial (Isaiah 53:3, 8)

- III : The Reason for Messiah’s Suffering
 - A: The Erroneous Conclusions of Man (Isaiah 53:4)
 - B: The Eternal Plan for Messiah (Isaiah 53:6, 10-12)

Conclusion:

Jesus told religious Nicodemus in John 3:17, ***“For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.”***, and He gave Nicodemus this assurance in John 3:18 telling him, ***“He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.”***

Conqueror’s Class member, if you have truly been born again, the unjust suffering of Messiah demands your all today, wouldn’t you say?

If Christ was willing to suffer all that He suffered for you and for me to have the opportunity to be made clean through His precious blood, shouldn’t you and I then be willing to love, and to serve, and to obey Him in all that we do today?
