Today's Lesson Thought can be summed up in this simple statement... "If Others Can Do It, Have Done It, And Are Still Doing It, Then So Can I!"

Today's Lesson Theme Verse is found in this passage of Scripture...
"Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting."

I : Never Forget What Christ Has Done For You

A: He Gave Himself For Me

III : Never Forget That What Others Have Done, You And I Can Do Also

A: If John the Baptist Could Do It, So Can You! (John 1:1-37)

B: If That Woman At The Well Can Do It, So Can You! (John 4:1-42)

C: If A Blind Man Who Was Given His Sight Can Do It, So Can You! (John 9:1-38)

D: If The Disciples Can Do It, So Can You! (John 20:19-31, Acts 4:33)

E: If I Can Do It, So Can You! (Ephesians 3:8, I Timothy 1:12-16)

Conclusion:

So how do I Tell Someone of this so great salvation?

First of all, make up your heart and mind and soul to simply be obedient unto God and do it!

Secondly, even as was the method of each of the folks we saw in our lesson today, never forget what God has done for you so that you might share that message with everyone you meet! The message of salvation is only shared with others through a grateful heart!

Thirdly, 'Stay In The Book and Allow The Book To Stay In You!'

Lastly, determine to do for Christ Jesus NOW what you may not be able to do later!
