A: Why Would They Choose Not To Believe?

o 1: They Forgot The Words of Jesus

o 2: They Were More Worried About Their Own Safety Than The Facts

▪ a: The Were Hiding In The Upper Room

- 3: After Seeing All That Had Happened To Jesus At The Crucifixion, They Did Not Truly Believe That Jesus Would Or Could Rise Again
 - a: Mark 16:11-14, Isaiah 52:15
